



REGULATION EFFORTS IN ALBERTA

On July 22, 2021, it was announced that the Canadian Massage and Manual Osteopathic Therapists Association (CMMOTA), the Certified Registered Massage Therapist Association (CRMTA), the Massage Therapist Association of Alberta (MTAA), the Natural Health Practitioners of Canada (NHPC), together with the Transitional Council for the College of Massage Therapists of Alberta (TC-CMTA) have formed the Alberta Working Group for the Regulation of Massage Therapy. This group will complete the tasks requested by the Alberta Health Minister and Alberta Health as the profession moves towards the introduction of legislation to regulate the profession. It will periodically provide Milestone Updates through the four major Associations as such milestones are achieved on the path to legislation introduction.
